

Clayton Community Theatre received considerable recognition from Arts for Life on March 13, 2021 when the nominations for the 2020 Theater Mask Awards were announced. Although it was a pandemic-shortened season for CCT as for the other eligible community theatres, Arts for Life maintained their standards and did not make as many nominations as they would have in another year.
